## **CAMPUS WEEK Transportation and Meals**

### **MEALS ON CAMPUS**

**BREAKFAST – HU STUDENTS & STUDENTS FAMILIES (graduation guests):** Continental Breakfast is available at no charge in the **Conference Hotel for all HU persons staying in the Hotel and the Motel - 6:30 a.m. -8:30 a.m.**

**The Bookstore Coffee Shop:** You may purchase Starbuck’s coffee, juices, and continental breakfast all week. **Hours: Monday through Thursday, 8 AM to 5 PM, Friday thru Sunday 8 AM – 2 PM**

### **LUNCH - RESIDENCY PARTICIPANTS:**

**Monday through Thursday:** the Cafeteria is open for lunch from 11 AM to 1 PM. Those planning to have lunch on Campus should plan to purchase lunch at the cafeteria.

**Friday & Saturday:** The Cafeteria is closed. The Bookstore Coffee Shop has sandwiches and salads, tea, coffee, and juice for purchase.

### **DINNER – HU STUDENTS**

**There are no places on campus for dinner. Choices for dinner are:**

- 1. Order in:** A list of restaurants is available at the desk of the Conference Hotel.
- 2. Drive to nearby restaurants** (There are quite a few good ones within a couple of miles – the campus hotels can provide a list). **Carpooling will depend on the number of cars available – that is, how many students drive to campus and how many rent a car at the airport.**
- 3. Creative solution:** Get extra salad and/or sandwiches from the bookstore to have for dinner. **All the rooms have refrigerators.**

**If you wish to go to a restaurant in the area (There are a variety within a couple of miles) you will need a car. There may be car-pools available. If you want to be certain of transportation off-campus, you will need to rent a car at the airport.**

### **TRANSPORTATION FROM THE AIRPORT (MCI)**

**Shuttles:** Shuttles are available from MCI to the Campus. The average cost to carry from one to three persons is \$60.00 one way. If you arrange to share the shuttle between three people, it would be \$20.00 each, one way.

**Car Rentals:** It is approximately \$51.00 a day to rent a compact car.

**If you wish to coordinate your travels from the Kansas City Airport to Unity Village to be cost effective for yourself and other students, please send your travel i.e. flight arrival/departure, car rental or shuttle information to [Marilyn@holosuniversity.org](mailto:Marilyn@holosuniversity.org) Please furnish your travel plans as well as your contact information so this information can be forwarded to other students w/same interest in mind.**

**If you are driving and are willing to help with a car pool to local restaurants for evening meals, please let Marilyn know.**

**MOTEL: This is an older Motel in good condition.  
RATES: 1 bed, one person: \$54.00, 2 persons: \$69.00  
2 twin beds: one person: \$68.50, 2 persons: \$83.50

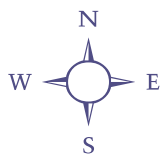

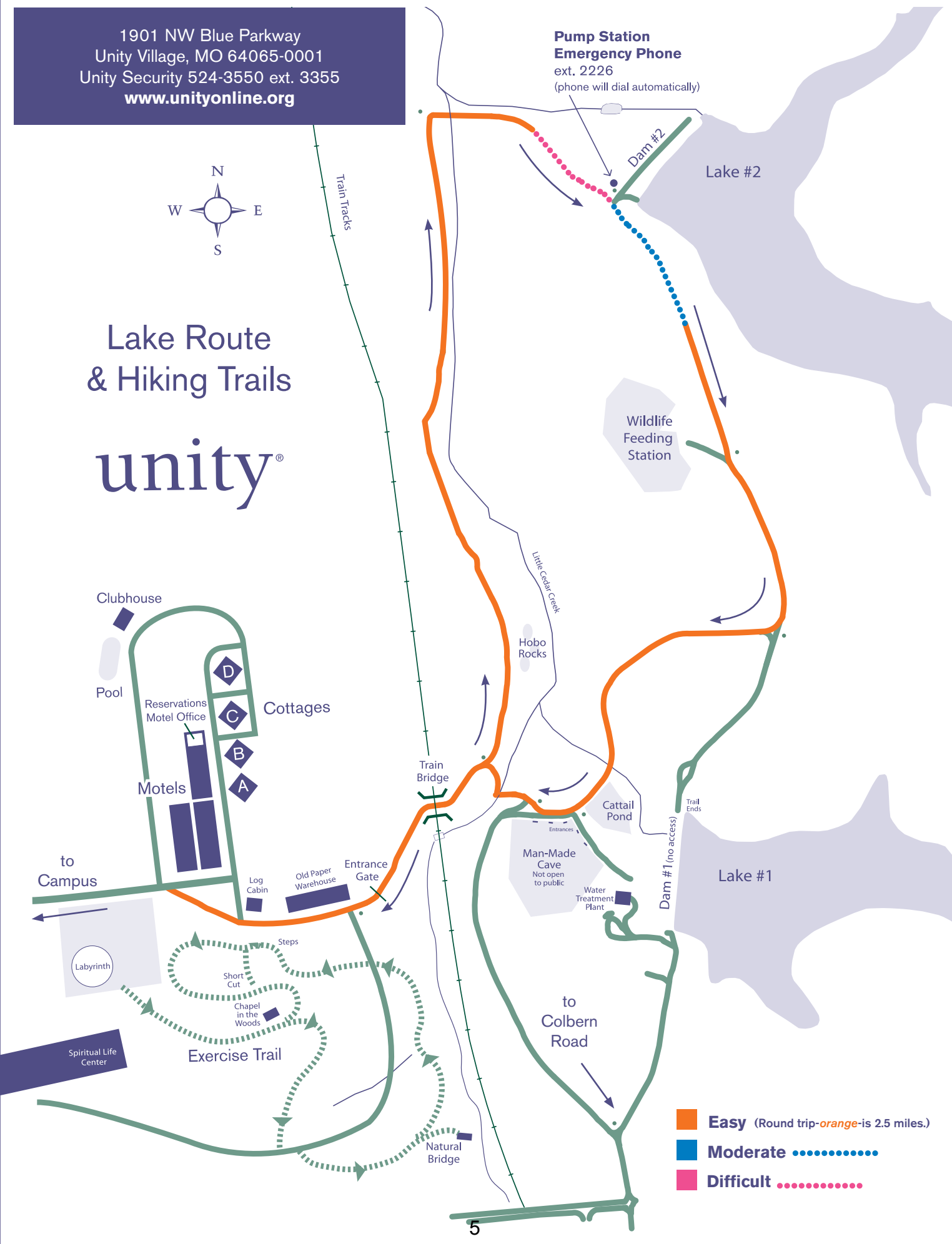

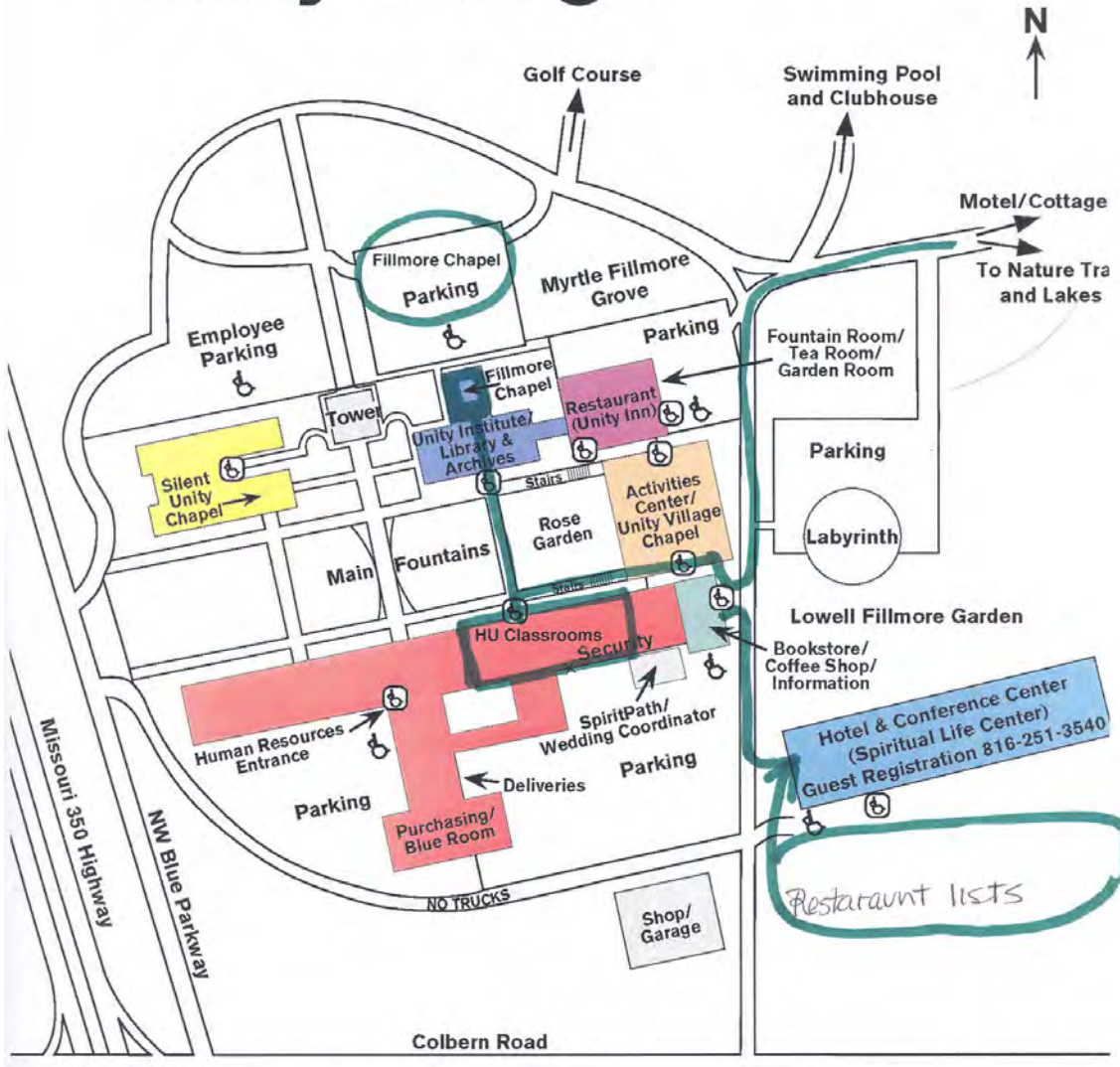
