**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Advanced Past Life Therapy builds upon the principles learned in Part I . This longer course includes supervised practice of Past Life Therapy by the student with fellow students and also with outside volunteers under supervision by Dr. Netherton. **Successful completion** leads to certification by Dr. Netherton as a Past Life Therapist.

**Prerequisites:**

Course 816. This is an academic course taught at University level. You will also conduct one or more PLT sessions, under supervision. This is an educational process and NOT therapy.

**Course Topics:**

- Review of Life's Psychic Structure
- Didactic overview and examples.
- Demonstration of the patterns from birth, prenatal experiences and past lives.
- Supervised Past Life Therapy Sessions by Each Student

**Course Objectives:**

The primary purpose of this course is to gain personal supervision while doing Past Life Therapy on other students and outside volunteers. Successful completion leads to certification by Dr. Netherton as a Past Life Therapist. A maximum of 12 students are accepted for this class.
